Two-time "Italian best jazz album" winner, **Danilo Rea** is one of Italy's leading jazz pianists. His music is rich of surprising moments of improvisation characterized by a great lyricism, which granted him to be compared to the piano legend Keith Jarret, especially after Rea performed an astonishing solo concert at the Guggenheim Museum, a single towering 90-minute spontaneous suite based on a new mix of arias, Italian songs and Rea originals.

His constant research of expressiveness through the instrument also conferred him the reputation of being a poet of jazz music.

Danilo Rea has been educated in classical music at Santa Cecilia Academy in Rome, but in his career he has covered a fair range of different music genres. Indeed, after the academic studies he experimented progressive music with one of his first bands, "New Perigeo", while developing his interest to jazz music with the "Trio di Roma", ensemble formed with Enzo Pietropaoli and Roberto Gatto. His rise in the jazz world was rapid and the Italian pianist got the honor to play with the most famous American soloists, such as Chet Baker, Lee Konitz, and John Scofield. Nonetheless, Danilo Rea does not take inspiration from the "Great American Songbook", but rather from his motherland and the traditional Italian classical and pop music. This is one of the reason why Danilo Rea also got to collaborate with a vast number of Italian great pop stars throughout his long career, such as Mina, Rino Gaetano, Claudio Baglioni, Pino Daniele and Adriano Celentano, and is still considered one of the greatest Italian piano performer in the jazz scene.
