An Italian classical guitarist, he started his musical career as a pianist, but soon moved to guitar, the instrument in which he proved his artistry. Last year he won the first prize both at the "European Moncalieri Music Competition" and at the international contest "Contea". Furthermore, he is both the creator and the artistic director of the classical guitar International Festival "Claxica", which in just a few years has become a point of reference in the national classical guitar scene, attracting both local and foreign famed players.

Alessio Monti

After the pop and rock experiences of his youth, Italian guitarist and composer Alessio Monti started to study classical music and to tour extensively eastward, incorporating the Oriental philosophy into his way of playing. Mr. Monti is also excellent in music explorations, of which his own guitar represents a proof, as it incorporates both a Kalimba and a resonator. His style is extremely innovative and will be of great interest to lovers of many genres, as it ranges from minimalist to jazz, and from Eastern to Western classical traditions. Maestro Monti actually lives in Thailand and teaches at the Music College of Payap University in Chiang Mai.

Fabio Montomoli

Fabio Montomoli is recognized by critics as one of the best classical guitar performer in the international scene, with a powerful sound provided with a vast timbre variety. His tours all around the world have covered many important capitals, ranging from Europe, Asia, and both North and South America. Mr. Montomoli is regularly invited to the most prestigious guitar festivals and is Art Director and Founder of two International Festivals, the "Festival Internazionale Chitarristico Palmiero Giannetti" in Grosseto, and the "Festival Internazionale Chitarristico Alvaro Mantovani" in Follonica.
